GRAND RAPIDS CHARTER TOWNSHIP SPECIAL JOINT MEETING OF THE TOWNSHIP BOARD AND PLANNING COMMISSION October 25, 2022

A meeting of the Grand Rapids Charter Township Board and Planning Commission was called to order at 3:00 pm by Supervisor DeVries. The meeting was held in the Township Hall. 1. DISCUSSION – MASTER LAND USE PLAN UPDATE.

Attorney Jim Brown gave an overview of the memo he prepared regarding the Master Land Use Plan, including major items to focus on for future land use and what was done in the last update.

The previous process was discussed, along with the advantages of a plan supplement versus completing a new plan. Public engagement was also discussed. There was a consensus that it would be best to move forward with a supplement.

There was agreement that the Planning Commission would start having discussions and public input on the different land use areas in the beginning of next year.
